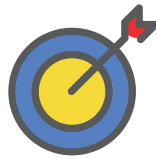
WHO WE ARE

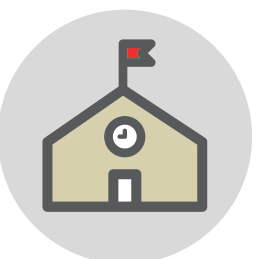

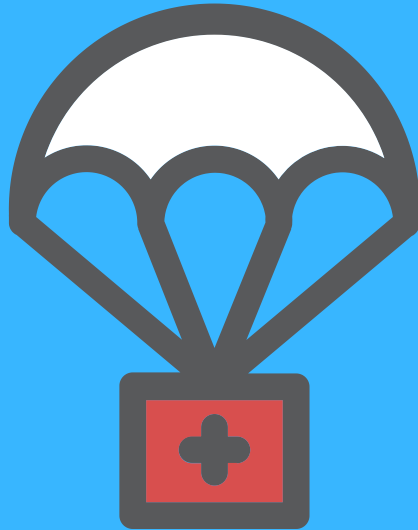

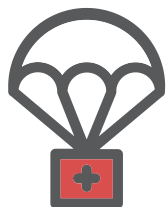

COVID-19 RESPONSE:

DISASTER RELIEF

The past year has been challenging for each and every one of us in many different ways. The emergence of the COVID-19 pandemic and the difficulties it has brought to the lives and livelihoods of individuals, families, communities, nations and the world more broadly is unfathomable. It is of course a public health crisis, but also a crisis in so many other areas of life - socially, economically, politically mentally and emotionally.

In turn, responses to this ongoing pandemic require creative and holistic approaches that recognise the multifaceted nature of this crisis and meet people at their point of need.

The team at AOGWR has sought to do just that and provide practical and timely assistance to people to help navigate the challenges and impacts of COVID-19.

Through our community-led development model, we have listened widely & provided CUSTOMISED COVID-19 responses that truly meet people's needs.

For many, the promoted essentials of staying COVID-19 safe were out of reach due to limited income. They were faced with the impossible choice between feeding their families and buying the needed soap, hand sanitiser and face masks.

Thanks to generous donors, we were able to raise funds and provide sanitation kits including these essentials and other hygiene items to 6,673 people.

We were also able to provide 719 children boarding in schools in remote and mountainous areas far away from their family and homes with essential hygiene and sanitation items to ensure their health and safety during this time.

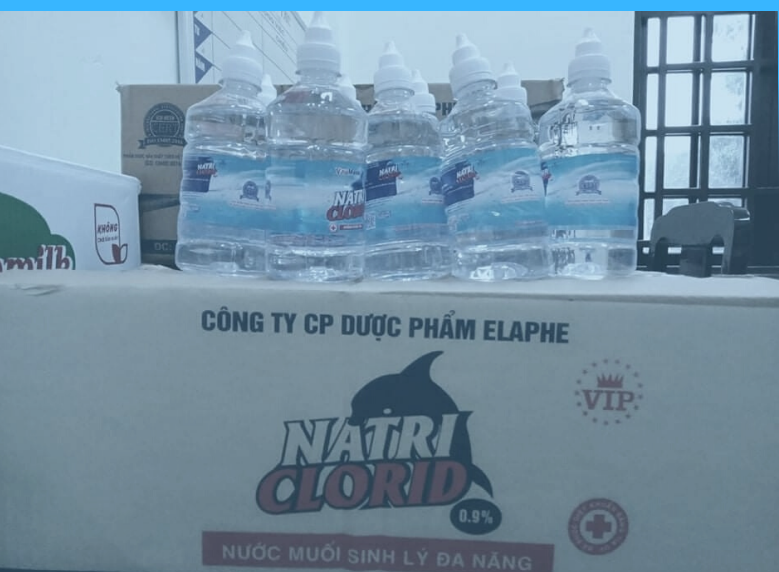

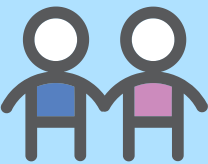

In addition to the many unexpected twists and turns of 2020, Vietnam was also hit with one of the worst typhoon seasons in recent memory.

Central Vietnam was the worst affected area with wave after wave of category two, three and four typhoons. The devastation was unfathomable: lives were lost, homes were destroyed, infrastructure was damaged, and property was ruined beyond repair.

In a short time, thanks to the generosity of our donors, we were able to mobilise a unique and highly effective response to the devastation caused by the typhoons and subsequent flooding and landslides.

With 1DAY funds, the AOGWR team was able to purchase and deliver vital supplies to practically assist with the clean up.

Cleaning and sanitation supplies were provided to 26 medical centres which see to the health needs of some 211,321 people of which 41,036 were children.

These supplies included: bleach, vinegar, sterilising equipment, brushes, mops, buckets, gloves, hand soap, water sterilisation tablets to sterilise wells and other water sources, cholera tablets and a range of other hygiene essentials for families in crisis.

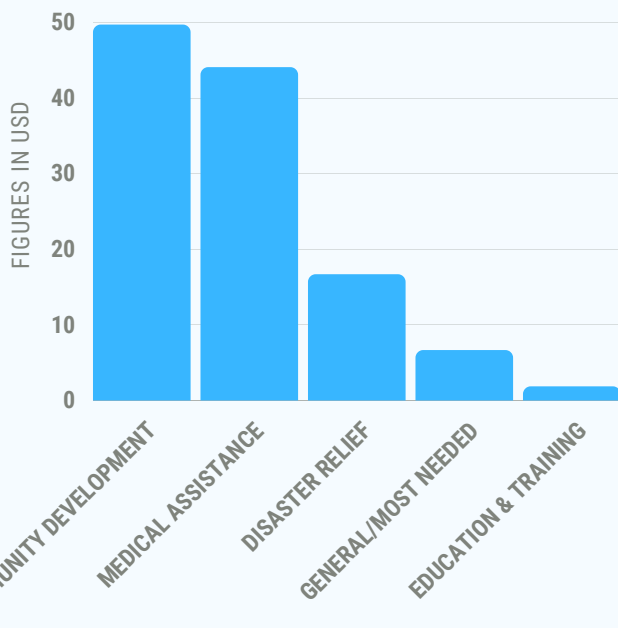

Income was received across five main categories: Community Development; Medical Assistance; Disaster Relief; Education & Training as well as General/Where Most Needed.

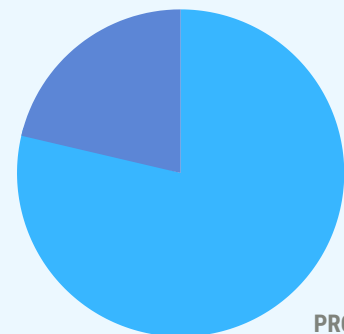
EXPENSES

We remain committed to transparency and good stewardship of funds.

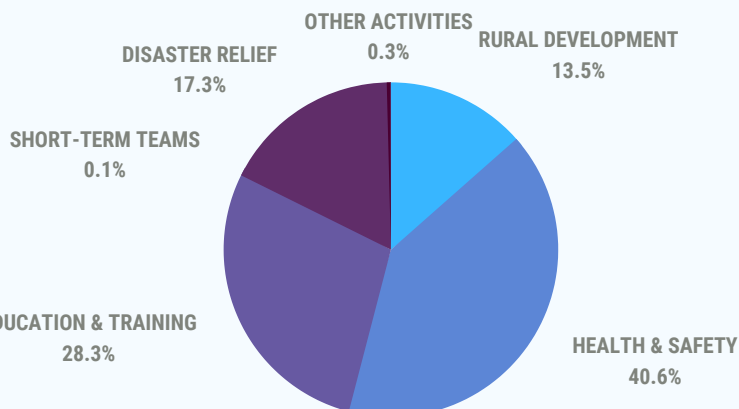
As such, funds were spent carrying out our community-led development activities, equipping and empowering the people we work with.
