We work relentlessly to bring about positive social change for the people of Vietnam and address expressions or experiences of poverty, injustice, and inequality.

Reaffirmed in their ability and capacity to effect change, people transform their societies






## OUR ACTIVITIES

Families with children are empowered to increase their household income.




#### HEALTH & SAFETY



# HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE

*The life-saving power of oxygen*

---

Much like water, it is an essential to all living things. Without it, we are in serious trouble.

Medical oxygen is a specific kind of compressed and pure oxygen that is a basic but essential medicine used to care for and treat patients globally whether it be for surgery, trauma, heart failure, asthma, pneumonia, maternal or early child care health.

*According to 2021 statistics, it was estimated that pneumonia accounts for 800,000 deaths annually of which 20%-40% are preventable with the availability of oxygen therapy [WHO 2021].*

The outbreak and continuation of the COVID-19 pandemic has highlighted the need for reliable access and availability of medical oxygen. It has also accelerated the demand and sense of urgency to acquire this life-saving medical essential.

Why? Because for those affected by severe cases of COVID-19, oxygen levels in the body can drop very low and when this happens, the cells within the body cannot function as they should, and if not treated, the cells themselves can stop working well or die altogether resulting in human fatalities.



As such, access to and distribution of medical oxygen to keep oxygen levels within a normal range is critical and a simple but life-saving treatment.

*The sad reality is that not everyone has access to medical oxygen because of supply shortages, a lack of technology, and/or funds to acquire it.*

In response to this critical need, AOGWR Vietnam has provided 26 medical oxygen generation machines to 13 different communes in remote mountainous areas.

Now installed and in active use, these generators are providing steady, safe, secure, and sustainable supplies of medical oxygen for:

**56,398 PEOPLE**

Words cannot convey our deep gratitude for the generous donors who made this project possible.

So many lives have been saved as a result and families kept together because of something as simple as air.

Again, we express our most profound thanks for your ongoing support and investment into the lives of the people of Vietnam.



